INFORMATION AND CONSENT ON PERSONAL DATA TREATMENT

In compliance with art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, we inform you that the personal data you provided will be subject to treatment based on compliance with the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights. To this end, you are provided with the following information:

Identity and details of the data holder: the **Associazione Comunità di Capodarco di Fermo**, based in Capodarco di Fermo, Via Vallescura, 47, C.F. 90031510440, is the data controller and processes the data for the purposes indicated below.

Categories of personal data processed: among the personal data that the Owner will treat there are:

- the data you provided upon signing this document and the previous waiver form;

- any data contained in the work object of the above waiver.

No specific categories of personal data will be collected and processed.

Processing purpose and legal basis: your personal data may be processed, only subject to your specific consent (Article 6 letter a) GDPR), to allow the Holder to publish, disclose and/or broadcast the work, within the XIII edition of "L'anello debole" Award and according to the preferences you expressed in the waiver above. The legal basis of such processing is the consent you have expressed.

Methods of treatment: the data collected will be processed in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, transparency, correctness, confidentiality, relevance and non-excess, both using paper and electronic devices, limited to the realization of the purposes for which they were collected. In order to make the above mentioned principles effective and, taking into account the state of the art and the implementation costs, as well as the nature, subject, context and purpose of the processing, the holder has implemented the appropriate technical and organizational measures to guarantee a level of safety adequate to the risk, as required by Article 32 of the regulation.

Nature of the provision of data: failure to provide data implies the impossibility of participating to the "L'anello debole".

Categories of recipients to whom the data may be disclosed: your data may be made accessible for the purposes referred to in point 3:

- to employees and consultants of the Holder acting as authorized individuals to process them;

- to third party companies or other subjects that carry out outsourcing activities on behalf of the Holder, acting as external data controllers. These third parties may process personal data only to the extent necessary to provide their services. Our data controllers and authorized parties have a contractual obligation to treat this information in strict confidence. Without the need for express consent, the Data Controller may disclose your data to public recipients by law, to the judicial authorities, as well as to all those subjects to whom the communication is mandatory for institutional purposes. These subjects will process the data acting as independent data controllers.

Data retention period: the data you provide will be kept for the period strictly necessary for the performance of the service for which they were collected.

Transfer of personal data to a third country or to an international organization outside the EU: your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or to an international organization outside the European Union. However, the Holder reserves the right to use services in "cloud", in which case, service providers will be selected among those who provide adequate guarantees, as required by art. 46 of the Regulation.

Appeal to the Supervisory Authority: the individual concerned is always entitled to file a complaint with one of the Supervisory Authorities where he/she is resident or he/she is at the time he/she provides the data, or with the Authority where the data Holder is established.

Rights of the individuals concerned: the Regulation provides and regulates a list of rights that belong to the party concerned and which you can exercise at any time. More specifically: Art. 15 - Right of access, Art.16 - Right of rectification, Art.17 - Right to cancellation (right to be forgotten), Art.18 - Right to limitation of treatment, Art.20 - Right to portability, Art.21 - Opposition right, Art.22 - Right not to be subjected to decisions resulting from automated processes.
